The ingenious FatDock – which also happily operates with non-Fatman brand amplifiers – includes a neat remote control, delivering full menu control of your docked Apple portable into the palm of your hand.

The FatDock's 3.5mm input means, in addition to docked Apples, you can hook-up practically any music-enabled device, including mobile phones, CD players, and MiniDisks. You can even connect your computer, via the headphone out socket.

The FatDock also takes care of charging and, via USB, synchronising duties for Apple portables. Factor in the dock's video outputs and the Wi-Tube system is perfectly prepared for today's varied home audio set-ups.
